Starting

According to the article of the UCI rules 2.1.005, the race can be attended by UCI professional teams registered in the Czech Republic, foreign UCI professional teams - max 2, UCI professional cyclocross teams, UCI continental teams, national selections, regional and club teams. 4 - 6 member teams consisting of competitors of the Elite men's category start. In accordance with Article 2.1.006 of the UCI Rules, U23 riders may also participate in the race.

Condition of participation

Invitation of the organizer, valid license for 2023. All participants in the race must have a valid passport or other personal document. It is necessary to comply with the visa requirement and any other rules of entry into the Czech Republic. Competitors,

including escorts, are obliged to submit a certificate of **individual health insurance, without this document the competitor will not be allowed to enter the race!** Proof of insurance from all team members will be submitted at registration or can be sent by email by August 31, 2023 at the latest.

Radiotour:

It will broadcast on 172,650 MHz, PL 123 Hz Each team is responsible for charging the batteries.

In case of failure to return the radio after the end of the race, a fine of 100 € will be charged.

Starting numbers

Each competitor will receive 2 starting numbers on the jersey, 1 frame number, 1x chip.

The set will be issued against a refundable deposit of 50 €. In case of return of an undamaged set, the deposit will be returned after the end of the race.

Convoy numbers

Convoy numbers will be distributed to the judges at the signature sheet table for the mass start stages.

Accommodation

It is provided and paid by the organizer for registered riders and escorts, i.e. 10 people (6x rider + 4x escort) in the city of Jindřichův Hradec and its surroundings throughout the race, i.e. from 6/9/2023 to 10/9/2023.

Boarding

Provided and paid by the organizer (in the form of half board) for registered riders and escorts, ie 10 people (6x rider + 4x escort) in the town of Jindřichův Hradec and its surroundings throughout the race. It starts on 06/09/2023 with dinner and ends on 10/09/2023 with breakfast.

Track marking

Black arrows in a light green field, placed on a signal before the intersection. Dangerous places will be marked with exclamation marks. It will be marked - 0 km and 30 km after the start and the last 25, 20, 10, 5, 4, 3 and 2 km boards - the last 1 km red cone 1 km last 500, 300, 200, 150, 100 and 50 m boards - scoring competition 1 km, 500 m, 200 m and tape on the road - mountain bonuses 1 km, 500 m, 200 m and tape on the road - finish with tape on the road and finish gate. Start + end of buffet and green zone boards.

Neutral mechanical cars:

The organizer provides three neutral mechanical vehicles.

Prescription

The race is run according to the UCI rules in category 2.2 and their directives. The stages take place in the regime of special use of the road by the Regional Authority of the South Bohemian Region. The track is closed by a continuous closure regime at intervals of 15 minutes. Competitors who are overtaken by the end vehicle of the continuous closure continue according to the rules of the road. Therefore, all participants must comply with the provisions of the Road Traffic Act No. 361/2000 Coll. and its later amendments. Competitors and their escorts are obliged to respect the instructions of the organizer, the Police of the Czech Republic, the Municipal Police and the referees. According to the rules, competitors are forbidden to enter a level crossing if an approaching train is seen or if a signal announces an approaching train. The organizer cannot be held liable for accidents or material damage caused to third parties before, during or after the race. The organizer reserves the right to make necessary changes to the schedule in case of unforeseen circumstances.

Doping control

It will be carried out according to the UCI Doping Control Rules. The starting numbers of the competitors drawn for doping control will be published at the finish of the race. The location of doping control will be specified in the manual for team leaders.

Introducing teams

Before each stage, as part of the signing of the starting sheets, the competitors will be introduced by a moderator on the podium. The order and schedule for the presentation of the teams will be presented and distributed together with the results in the organizer's community.

Signature sheets

All competitors are obliged to sign the signature sheets, which will be issued in the start area 70 – 10 minutes before the start of the race.

Official handover of jerseys

It will take place after each stage when the results are announced.

Announcement of results

The results of each stage and the interim results will be announced immediately after the finish at the end of the stage:

The first three competitors at the end of the stage leading competitor in the overall ranking - yellow jersey, leading competitor in the scoring competition - green jersey, leading competitor in the mountain competition - white jersey with red dots, leading competitor in the U23 category - white jersey.

Announcement of the overall ranking after the end of the race - immediately after finishing the race in the finish area: the first three competitors in the overall ranking, the first competitor in the scoring competition - green jersey, the first competitor in the mountain competition - white jersey with red dots, the first competitor in the U23 category - white jersey, the best team.

Price breakdown

Financial rewards belong to competitors placed in the given stage for 1st – 20th place and for the overall rating for 1st – 20th place. Financial prizes and jerseys belong to competitors placed in the competitions of points, climbing, U23 for the overall rating on the 1st – 3rd place. The financial reward belongs to the competitors of the team placed in the team competition in the overall ranking on the 1st place. The condition for the payment of the financial reward is the personal participation of the competitor in the final announcement of the results. Competition conditions

1. Bonus

Bonuses for stage victory are 10 sec. for 1st place, 6 sec. for 2nd place and 4 sec. for 3rd place.

Bonuses for speed premium are for 1st place 3 sec., for 2nd place 2 sec. and for 3rd place 1 sec.

2. The following competitions are announced in the race

1. Individual competition – yellow jersey

The winner of this competition will be the competitor with the lowest sum of times from each stage, including bonuses and penalties. In the case of equal times in the final ranking, the following are decisive:

Lower sum of placings in individual stages,
better placement in the last stage.

The leader of this competition will receive a yellow jersey, in which he is obliged to start.

2. Scoring competition - jersey green

Points for placing at the speed bonuses and at the finish of the stages count towards this competition. The points are scored as follows: for the speed bonus 1st – 3rd place - 5, 3 and 1 point
in stage 1st – 15th place - 25, 20, 16, 14, 12, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 point

The winner of this competition will be the competitor who gets the most points. If more riders have equal points, the decisive factor is: higher number of wins in individual stages, higher number of wins in speed bonuses, better placement in the overall individual qualification.

The leader of this competition will receive a green jersey in which he is obliged to start.

1. Mountaineering competition - white jersey with red polka dots

Points for placing in mountain bonuses are included in this competition. The first five competitors of the mountain bonus score - 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 point.

The winner of this competition will be the competitor who gets the most points.

If more competitors have equal points, the following factors are decisive: higher number of victories in mountain bonuses, better placement in the overall qualification of individuals.

The leader of this competition will receive a white jersey with red dots, in which he is obliged to start.

2. Competition for the best competitor U23 - jersey white

The winner of this competition will be the best placed competitor born between 2001 and 2004 in the overall ranking of the individual competition. The leader of this competition will receive a white jersey, in which he is obliged to start.

3. Team competition

The evaluation of the team competition in the stage is done by summing up the times of the three best placed competitors according to time.

In the case of equal times for more than one team, the following shall decide:

1. better sum of placings of the first three competitors in the given stage, - placement of the best rider of the team at the end of the stage.

The leading team of the race will receive yellow starting numbers, with which it is obliged to start.

The overall evaluation of the team competition is made by the sum of the times achieved by the team in each stage.

If the cooperatives cannot be divided in this way, the following shall decide:

2. a higher number of first places in the daily team classification,
3. higher number of second places, etc., the last then according to
4. Placing the best competitor in the overall individual ranking

A team reduced to less than 3 competitors is excluded from the evaluation of the team competition.

Priority of wearing jerseys

In the event that the competitor will be the leading competitor in more competitions, the competitor placed in the second place in the competition will receive the jersey or in other places. Jersey priority:

1. Yellow
2. Green
3. White with red polka dots
4. White

Buffer zone

According to the article of the UCI Rules 2.6.027, if a competitor is affected by a fall, puncture or mechanical accident recognized by the judges in the zone 3 km before the finish of the stage with a mass start, he will be assigned the time of the competitors (competitor) with whom he rode together at the time of the accident. He will be classified in the order in which he crossed the finish line. If a competitor is unable to cross the finish line as a result of a fall in the zone 3 km before the finish of the stage with a mass start, which was stated by the judges, he will be classified in the last place of the stage and will be assigned the time of the competitors (competitor) with whom he rode together at the time of the fall. All stages with a mass start are counted as mass finishes.

Time limit

The time limit for each stage is 15%. Only in exceptional unforeseeable cases and in case of force majeure, the referee board may extend the time limit in the stage after consultation with the organizer.

Penalization

In case of offences, only the UCI penalty table will be applied.
